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FINANCIAL FEE INFORMATION

Parents are required to sign an Annual Fee Agreement to pay school fees. This Annual Fee Agreement will be issued at the beginning of each school year. Should the parents or guardians fail to return the Annual Fee Agreement to pay school fees, duly signed, to the school before the set date, the parents will be obliged to settle the annual school fees in full, on or before the last day of February of that year.

1. PREAMBLE

- 1.1 School fees are payable annually in advance on or before **1st January of that academic year.**
- 1.2 The School is prepared to accept payment of annual school fees in 11 monthly installments and no indulgence or latitude will be construed as a waiver or novation of any rights the school may have.

2. UNDERTAKING

- 2.1 I/We, the undersigned, hereby acknowledge liability for the annual school fees and I/we undertake to pay the annual school fees.
- 2.2 I/We further undertake:
 - 2.2.1 To pay the school fees punctually in accordance with the provisions of this agreement.
 - 2.2.2 In the event that I/we decide to remove the learner from the school, I/we undertake to notify the School Bursar in writing at least a FULL TERM prior to the learner being so removed. Furthermore, should I/we fail to give such notice directly to the School Bursar; I/we acknowledge liability to pay pro-rata school fees for a period of a FULL TERM after the learner has left the school.

3. DEFAULT

- 3.1 Should I/we fail to make payment in accordance with this agreement then the full balance of the school fees then outstanding will immediately become due, owing and payable on the last day of February of the current academic year.
- 3.2 Should I/we fail to make payments in accordance with this agreement, the school may institute legal action against me/us for collection of the arrear school fees, in which event I/we shall be liable for costs on the scale as between Attorney and client, including collection commission and VAT thereon.
- 3.3 Parents/Guardians shall be jointly and severally liable for payment of school fees irrespective of their marital status.

- 3.4 I/We nominate both my/our home or my/our work address/s as my/our *domicilium citandi et executandi* for service of legal process and Plaintiff may elect to serve at either address.
- 3.5 A certificate signed by the Principal or the Bursar shall be *prima facie* proof of any amount outstanding in terms of this agreement.

4. **GENERAL**

- 4.1 This agreement must be signed by both parents/guardians.
- 4.2 No variation or amendment of this agreement will be of any force or effect, unless it is reduced to writing and signed by the parents/guardians and the school.

5. **PERMISSION TO CONDUCT CREDIT SEARCHES**

CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT AT THE SCHOOL

1. A non-refundable registration fee of R200 is payable to the school at the time the application for admission is submitted.
2. The applicants understand that the school is a ministry of One Life Church, Pietermaritzburg and therefore carries with it the spiritual mandate of Jesus Christ (see Mission Statement). Pupils will be expected to attend the Christian activities of the school.
3. If the application for admission is approved by the school an admission fee of R1000 must be paid on the said date. No pupil will be admitted to the school unless this non-refundable amount has been paid.
4. If the Headmaster at any time requires that a pupil be removed from the school, full fees and other amounts payable in respect of such a pupil will remain due to the school except to any extent decided by the School Board.
5. The school may in its sole discretion grant funds and make changes or adjustments to fees. There shall be no entitlement to any rebate of fees if the pupil is absent for any portion of a term owing to illness or any other cause.
6. The applicant for both himself/herself and the pupil, to comply with the rules, regulations, policies and procedures of the school as enunciated by the Headmaster acting in his capacity as such.
7. The applicants hereby agree to indemnify and hold blameless the Church, the School Board, its Headmaster and staff or their authorized agents or representatives against any and all claims howsoever arising including negligence, but not gross negligence, whether claimable by us, or by the pupil, or by any third party arising out of injury, death, loss, damage, costs or expense including legal costs, suffered by the pupil while enrolled at the school.
8. The parent/s hereby nominate/s the home address appearing on the application form as his/her/their chosen *domicilium citandi et executandi* for services of all notices or legal process in connection with any claim/s arising from this application. The parent/s shall be entitled to give one month's written notice to the school to change such address, provided that the new address is a physical address in the Republic of South Africa.
9. Any agreement purporting to vary terms of this agreement or any consensual cancellation, shall not be valid unless in writing and signed by both the parents and a duly authorized representative of the school.
